1. What data do we collect?

Mase collects the following data:

- Personal information (Name, email address, phone number, bank account (IBAN) number, address, date of birth)

2. How do we collect your data?

You directly provide MASE with this data when you register to become a member of MASE

3. How will we use your data?

MASE collects data so that we can:

- Send you emails with updates about MASE
- Deduct the yearly membership fee and other costs (that explicitly opted-in for) from your bank account
- Send MASE specific post to your home address

4. How do we store your data?

MASE will store your personal information from the time you sign up, until you decide to cancel your membership. Once your membership is cancelled, we will delete your data within a month.

5. What are your data protection rights?

MASE would like to make sure that you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights.

Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request MASE for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that MASE correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request MASE to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that MASE erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that MASE restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to MASE's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that MASE transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

6. What are cookies: Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our website, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies.

MASE uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

- Understanding how you use our website

8. What types of cookies do we use?

- Analytics – MASE uses these cookies installed by Google Analytics. These cookies are used to calculate visitor, session, campaign data and keep track of site usage for the site's analytics report. These cookies also store information of how visitors use a website and help in creating an analytics report of how the website is doing. The data collected including the number visitors, the source where they have come from, and the pages visited. These cookies store information anonymously and assign a randomly generated number to identify unique visitors.

9. How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the aforementioned website (www.allaboutcookies.org) tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.

10. Privacy policies of other websites

The MASE website may contain links to other websites. Our privacy policy applies only to our website, so if you click on a link to another website, you should read their privacy policy.
